





LEARNING FROM MENTORSHIP













LEARNING FROM ELEVATION

This year's Project Pipeline was our first in-person camp. We were hosted by the Boston Public Library in Roxbury which was in close proximity to the site location used in our curriculum. Thanks to our sponsors, we were able to provide the camp and all materials to the students free of charge!

DAY 1 - On Day 1 of the camp, students were introduced to the site and context in Roxbury on Washington Street. They were tasked with designing an Entryway to the communal space.

DAY 2 - The students progressed their designs on Day 2 to create a street-facing Facade for their clients! They began with 2D sketches and then modeled the facades in 3D using clay and other materials.

DAY 3 - On the last day of the camp, the students finished their facade models and began thinking of the streetscape. They designed furniture and planting and used what they learned about wayfinding to even add signs and colors to the sidewalk in front of their building facade.




